Michael Fraizer is a senior project manager and contracting officer's representative in the Innovation Sector of the Federal Systems Integration and Management Center (FEDSIM). He manages a portfolio of SBIR III contracting projects for US Space Force and US Air Force clients totaling over \$500 million in contract value.

Prior to joining the General Services Administration in 2021, Michael was an acquisition program manager in Space Systems Command. His primary role at Space Systems Command was leading an integrated program team through a system transformation and migration to cloud computing of the Space Weather Analysis and Forecast System. He also served in leadership roles in the commercial evaluation environment which provided a testbed for evaluating commercially available software and data for rapid integration into the space surveillance mission systems and the "Pivot Space Domain Awareness" imperative.

Michael worked in financial services for Charles Schwab and Capital One in project management roles before entering civil service in 2019. He led an information technology infrastructure project at Charles Schwab that completely overhauled the capital markets trading and accounting platform that is the primary revenue driver for Schwab. He led projects at Capital One that included stakeholders from retail banking, marketing, training, information technology, small business banking, and commercial banking.

Michael was an Army officer from 1997 until he retired in 2015. He was an infantry officer for the first half of his career with assignments in the 101st Airborne Division at Fort Campbell, Kentucky, and the 1st Infantry Division in Germany. Following his infantry assignments, Michael transitioned into Russian-speaking foreign area officer roles with assignments to US Embassies in Moscow, Russia; Tbilisi, Georgia; and Bishkek, Kyrgyzstan, and a final assignment to the Defense Intelligence Agency in Washington, DC.
